

PUBLIC HEARING FOR BYLAW 03/2013 – OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN AND BYLAW 04/2013 – ZONING BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MARCELIN HELD ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 22ND, 2014 AT THE MARCELIN VILLAGE OFFICE

It was recommended by Council to amend the Zoning bylaw as follows:

That under all districts, the section regarding accessory buildings should include “Temporary, fabric covered structures consisting of wood, metal, or plastic framing covered on the roof and one or more sides with fabric, plastic, vinyl or other sheet material shall be permitted in a rear or side yard of an existing principal building, all year round, and shall not exceed 120 square feet.”
