**Hall Rentals**

Kathy Verbonac has agreed to be the contact for hall rentals. Hall rental rates have not changed in the past few years and remain as follows:

- \$200 Hall Rental per day
- \$100 each additional consecutive day
- \$100 non-refundable deposit – must be paid within 48 hours after booking
- \$200 damage deposit
- \$75 using the hall for setup or preparation the day before
- \$50 deposit for use of microphone
- \$100 damage deposit for Gazebo (cleaning prior to and after is up to the renter)

## Memberships

Lee Rejc will be heading up the sale of memberships for the new year. Memberships remain at \$5.00 and anyone who is 16 years of age or older is eligible to be a member. The memberships run from November 1 to October 31 of each year.
